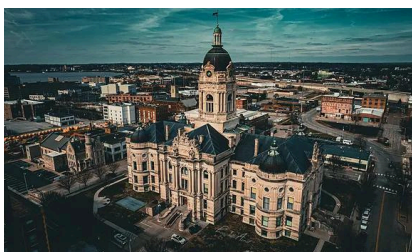
HISTORY OF THE OLD COURTHOUSE

The Old Courthouse in Vanderburgh County is considered by architectural historians to be one of the most important examples of 19th-century governmental architecture in the country. It was designed by Henry Wolters of Louisville, Kentucky.

The Courthouse exemplifies Beaux Arts architecture, which was just coming into vogue at the time of the Courthouse's design, replacing heavier Victorian styles. Wolters himself studied at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, France.



The Courthouse occupies a full city block bound by Fourth, Vine, Fifth, and Court streets in Downtown Evansville. The block in which the Courthouse resides was once a turnaround basin for the Wabash and Erie Canal, the longest canal constructed in North America, running for more than 460 miles, before it was filled in around 1860.



Dominating the skyline of Downtown Evansville, the Bell Tower is the Courthouse's most prominent feature, which is 216 feet high with four clock faces.

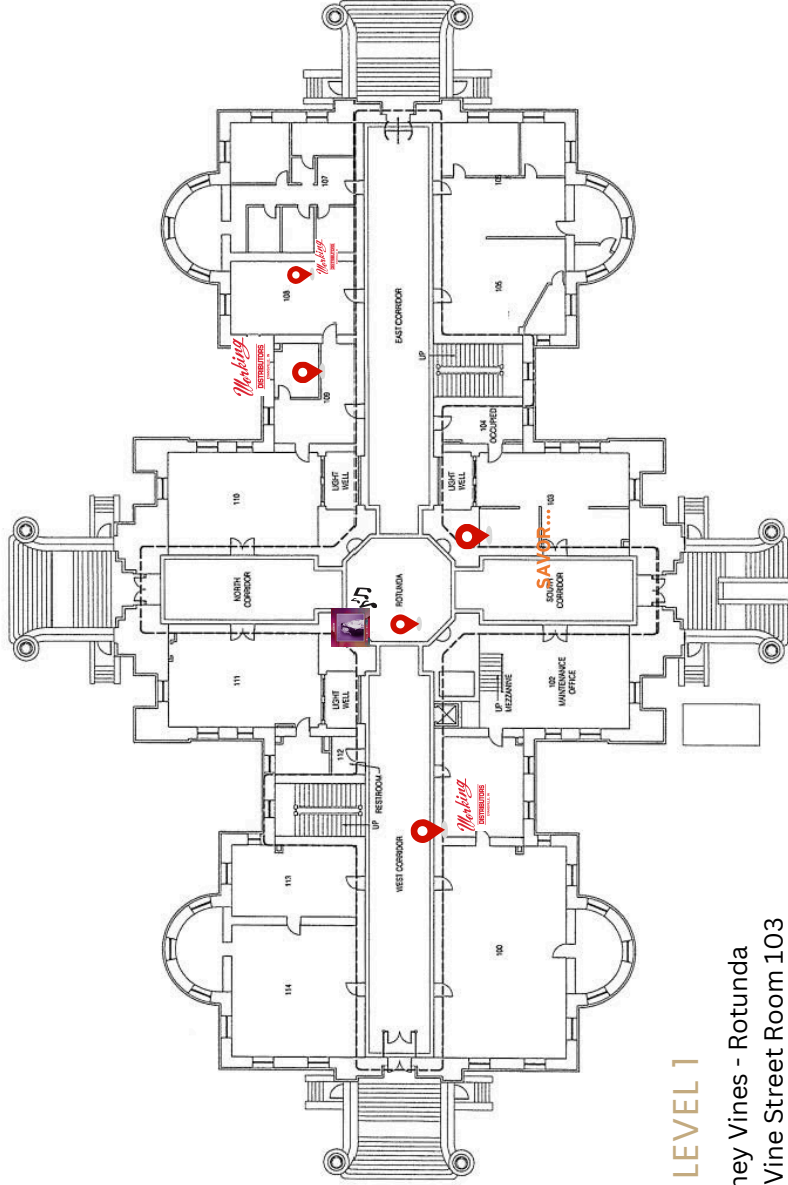

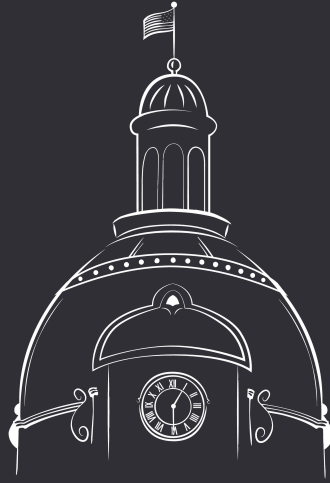
